1. INTRODUCTION

CEM is committed to protecting your personal data and respecting your privacy.

This privacy statement explains the reasons for processing your personal data in the context of the Conference on Precision Electromagnetic Measurements 2026. It describes how we collect, handle, and ensure the protection of all personal data provided, how that information is used, and what rights you have in relation to your personal data. It also specifies the contact details of the responsible Data Controller with whom you may exercise your rights, as well as the Data Protection Officer and the European Data Protection Supervisor.

The information related to the processing of data for the Conference on Precision Electromagnetic Measurements 2026, carried out by Centro Español de Metrología OA.MP. (CEM), is presented below.

2. WHY AND HOW DO WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

Purpose of the processing operation: CEM collects and further processes your personal data to provide you with information about the Conference on Precision Electromagnetic Measurements 2026 (before, during, and after the event) and to process your application for participation.

Audio-visual recordings of the speakers, organisers, and participants will be taken at the conference, as well as photographs of speakers and panoramic photographs of participants and organisers. These may be partially published on the event website and used for communication purposes by CEM and Quality Media, the event organizer.

Audio-visual recordings are also used for drafting minutes.

Audience members or non-speaker participants are not photographed individually or in groups but may appear in panoramic photographs of the whole event or audience.

Participants who do not wish to be included in recordings or publications may object to processing. They should inform the organisers by email at ahortelano@cem.es prior to the meeting if they do not wish to be photographed.

Your personal data will not be used for any automated decision-making, including profiling.

3. ON WHAT LEGAL GROUND(S) DO WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

The processing of personal data related to the organisation, management, follow-up, and promotion of the Conference on Precision Electromagnetic Measurements 2026 (including photos, audiovisual recordings, addresses, names, and positions) is necessary for the management and functioning of the event, based on Ley Orgánica 3/2018, de 5 de diciembre, de Protección de Datos Personales y garantía de los derechos digitales and Reglamento (UE) 2016/679 del Parlamento Europeo y del Consejo de 27 de abril de 2016 (GDPR), specifically Article 13.

Your explicit consent is required for:

- Sharing the participants' list (containing your name and affiliation) with other attendees for internal networking purposes within the event network;
- Sharing the meeting/event attendee list with participants to create working groups for collaborative work launched during the event;
- Processing your personal data to invite you to future events organised by the data controller within the Conference on Precision Electromagnetic Measurements;
- Processing your personal data to manage your subscription to the data controller's newsletter;
- Sharing your postal address, name, and optionally telephone number to ship a package with ingredients for the social event, between CEM staff responsible for the organisation and Quality Producciones, the company in charge of preparing and sending the packages.

By opting in, you give explicit consent under Article 5(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 to process your personal data for these specific purposes.

4. WHICH PERSONAL DATA DO WE COLLECT AND FURTHER PROCESS?

We process the following personal data: contact details (function/title, first name, last name, name of organisation, city, country, email address, telephone number, postal address).

5. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

The Data Controller keeps your personal data only as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose of collection or further processing.

Retention details:

- All personal data related to the organisation and management of the Conference on Precision Electromagnetic Measurements 2026 (including registration information before, during, or after the event) will be deleted after the last related action.
- Audio-visual recordings of the Conference will be retained as a source of information for researchers.
- Personal data shared for future mailing purposes (e.g., newsletters or invitations) are processed according to the Record of Processing on Management of Subscriptions.

6. HOW DO WE PROTECT AND SAFEGUARD YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

All personal data in electronic format (e-mails, documents, databases, uploaded batches of data, etc.) are stored either on the servers of the CEM [or of its contractors-interpretation and platform management). All processing operations are carried out pursuant Spanish General Administration legal framework.

CEM's contractors are bound by a specific contractual clause for any processing operations of your personal data on behalf of the Commission, and by the confidentiality obligations deriving from the General Data Protection Regulation mentioned above

In order to protect your personal data, CEM has put in place a number of technical and organisational measures. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access, taking into consideration the risk presented by the processing and the nature of the personal data being processed. Organisational measures include restricting access to the personal data solely to authorised persons with a legitimate need to know for the purposes of this processing operation.

7. WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND TO WHOM IS IT DISCLOSED?

Access to your personal data is provided to CEM (and contractors) staff responsible for carrying out this processing operation and to other authorised CEM staff according to the "need to know" principle. Such staff abide by statutory, and when required, additional confidentiality agreements. Access to the address/telephone you provided will also be shared with the transport company for the purpose of transportation during the event

8. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND HOW CAN YOU EXERCISE THEM?

You have specific rights as a 'data subject' under Chapter II, Title III (Articles 14-25) of Ley Orgánica 3/2018, de 5 de diciembre, de Protección de Datos Personales y garantía de los derechos digitales, in particular the right to access, your personal data and to rectify them in case your personal data are inaccurate or incomplete. Where applicable, you have the right to erase your personal data, to restrict the processing of your personal data, to object to the processing, and the right to data portability.

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data, in accordance with the regulation mentioned above.

You can withdraw your consent at any time by notifying the data controller by sending an e-mail to ahortelano@cem.es. The withdrawal of your consent will not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out before you have withdrawn the consent.
